ONE - Activities



"ONE" SKIT PROJECT

8 Players + narrator and a ready audience!

Description: Create colors on cut out circles with corresponding numbers on the back of it. Players will perform a skit, using the book, "ONE"

Materials: Acrylic Paint for colors: GRAY, BLUE, RED, GREEN, ORANGE, PURPLE, YELLOW, "NO" (and "THE END" on the other side); Poster Board or Foam Core

"ONE" APPRECIATION FLOWERS

Description: Kids create a bouquet of paper flowers together. The goal is to introduce the topic of appreciation of each other's differences. Each participant will be responsible for creating their own paper flower to add to the final bouquet. The CENTER of the flower will be represented by the student's favorite color (i.e. Blue) and they must write why they appreciate and liked this color. However, the PETALS will be represented by the favorite COLOR chosen by their neighbors to the LEFT and to the RIGHT. (i.e. Purple and Yellow). They must write down on the back of the flower what they appreciate about not just the color chosen by their neighbors but about the students themselves.

Materials: different colored construction paper, scissors, glue stick, marker, and pipe cleaners, and a vase.
